

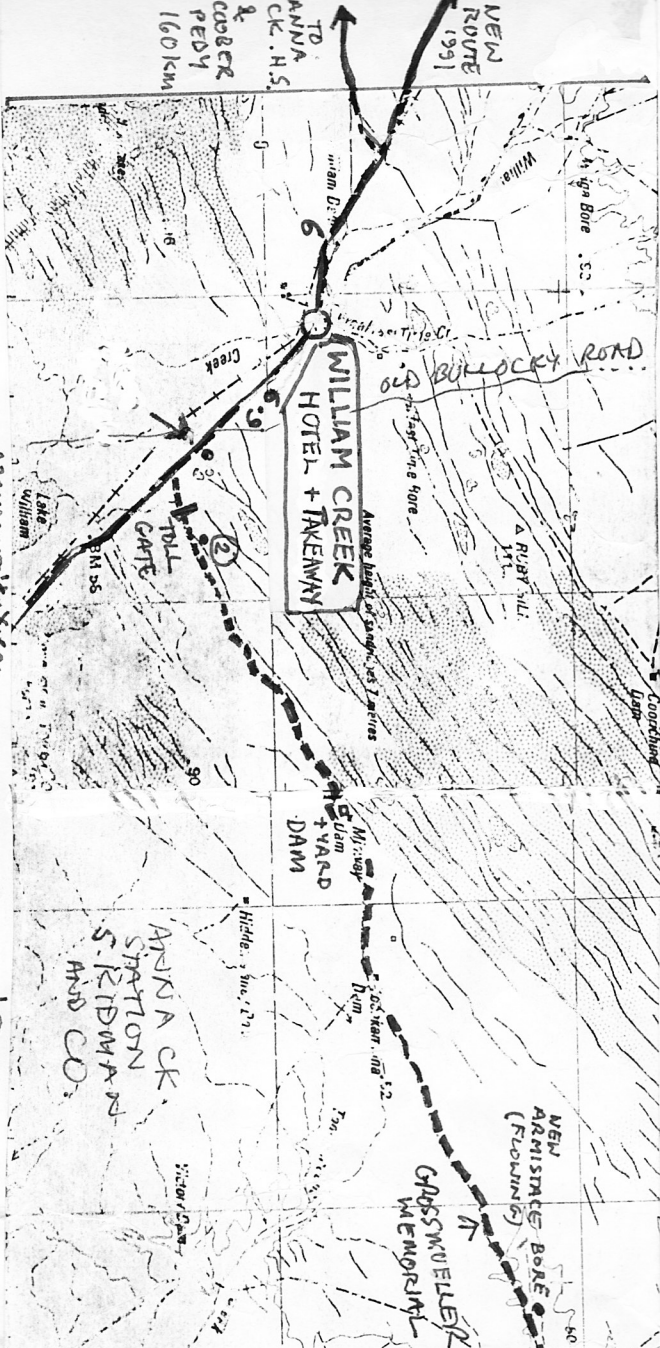

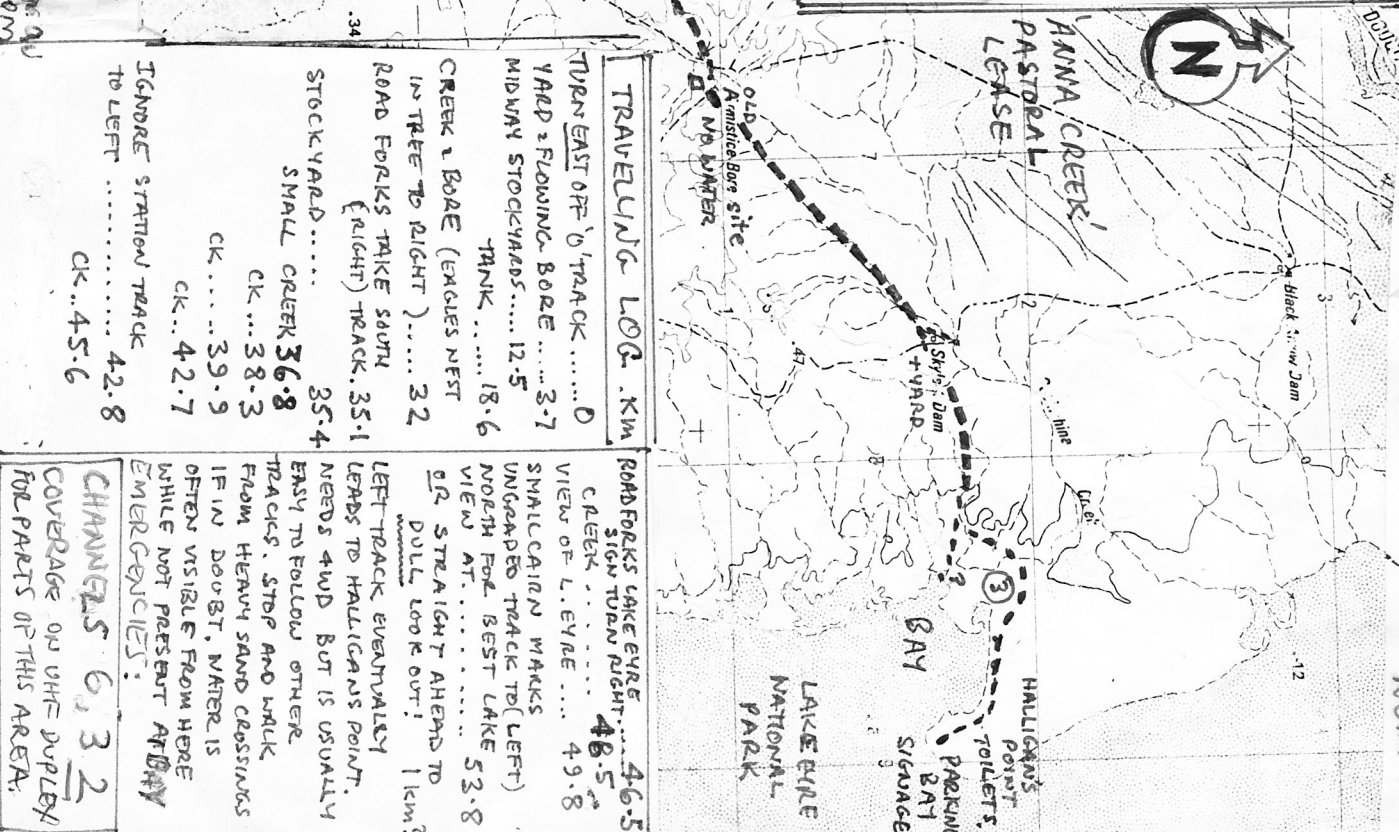
LAKE EYRE NORTH

**THIS TRACK:** leading to a view of lake Eyre North, runs from the ODDNADATA track 7 km south of William Ck. It is all dirt track, occasionally

graded, in part, by Anna Ck. station, whose pastoral lease (cattle) covers all the track up to the high water mark of Lake Eyre North. From this work the land is within a National Park and an entrance pass is required. You are not allowed to shoot, leave any rubbish or remove any article, nor camp within 1 km of a cattle watering point. Because of high summer temperatures and sporadic visitation it is unwise to travel with only one vehicle especially in high temperatures or stormy weather. It is better to check conditions at William Creek, then teleph one family/friends with intentions to call Police at Coobers Pedy, Marree or ODDNADATA. These are all 50c calls from the worlds "loneliest phone box" at William Creek (STD. 24th PHONE) Campers with tents should beware of unpredictable strong winds at any hour of night & day, near L. Eyre. Also that the most direct route to the lake is least interesting - take the lakeside track north!

LEFT TRACK EVENTUALLY LEADS TO HALLIGAN'S POINT. NEEDS 4WD BUT IS USUALLY EASY TO FOLLOW OTHER TRAILS. STOP AND WALK FROM HEAVY SAND CROSSINGS IF IN DOUBT. WATER IS OFTEN VISIBLE FROM HERE WHILE NOT PRESENT AT DRY EMERGENCIES.
